VISITOR ARRIVALS AND SPENDING INCREASED FOR THE FIRST HALF OF 2015

International Convention Brought Thousands to the State in June 2015

HONOLULU – For the first half of 2015, visitor arrivals to the Hawaiian Islands rose four percent and visitor spending increased to \$7.6 billion¹ (+3.5%), according to preliminary statistics released today by the Hawai'i Tourism Authority. Growth in arrivals was led by more visitors from U.S West (+8.7%) and U.S. East (+1.8%), which balanced fewer visitors from Japan (-2.1%) and Canada (-1.2%). Expenditures by U.S. West (+7.3% to \$2.6 billion) and Canadian (+3.6% to \$669.9 million) visitors increased, but U.S. East (-1.4% to \$1.9 billion) and Japanese (-11% to \$987.4 million) visitor expenditures declined compared to the first half of 2014².

All four larger Hawaiian Islands saw growth in arrivals compared to the first half of 2014: Maui (+5.7%), Kaua'i (+5.3%), Hawai'i Island (+5.2%) and O'ahu (+2.6%). Higher daily spending contributed to growth in visitor expenditures on Maui (+7.7% to \$2.2 billion) and Kaua'i (+15.8% to \$821.1 million) compared to the first half of 2014. Visitor expenditures on O'ahu (\$3.5 billion) and Hawai'i Island (\$935.4 million) were comparable to a year ago.

For the month of June 2015, the Lions Clubs International Convention brought nearly 18,000 delegates from 130 countries and boosted visitor growth throughout the state. Total arrivals rose six percent to 767,905 visitors. Arrivals by air grew 6.1 percent to 767,408 visitors, offsetting a 64.4 percent decline in arrivals by cruise ships. Total visitor days³ rose five percent compared to June 2014. Convention visitors from U.S. East and Canada tripled, in addition to significant growth from Japan (+56.4%) and U.S. West (+62.5%). Total visitor expenditures gained 4.4 percent to \$1.3 billion.

For U.S. West, growth in arrivals (+8% to 343,941 visitors) led to a 3.9 percent in visitor expenditures to \$514 million. Their average daily spending of \$158 per person was down 1.2 percent compared to June 2014 (\$160 per person). U.S. East arrivals increased 8.5 percent to 186,795 visitors, and daily spending rose to \$203 per person (+3.6%). This led to a 10.2 percent growth in visitor expenditures to \$390.7 million.

Japanese arrivals declined 2.3 percent to 118,911 visitors. Lower daily spending (-10% to \$254 per person) also resulted in an 11.7 percent drop in visitor expenditures to \$174.3 million.

Arrivals from Canada rose 9.2 percent to 18,715 visitors in June 2015. However, a shorter length of stay and decreased daily spending (-6.8% to \$152 per person) caused visitor expenditures to decline to \$32.2 million (-4.3%). Arrivals from All Other markets grew 5.7 percent to 99,046 visitors. Expenditures from All Other visitors was \$228.3 million, 12.7 percent higher than in June 2014.

There were 1,043,885 total air seats to Hawai'i in June 2015, up 9.2 percent from a year ago. Growth in scheduled seats from Canada (+26.5%), U.S. East (+21.6%), Oceania (+20.2%) and U.S. West (+12%) offset fewer seats from Other Asia (-14.5%) and Japan (-4.5%).

Other Highlights:

- The total number of visitors who came for corporate meetings, conventions and incentives (MCI) climbed 59.2 percent to 50,395 in June 2015. More visitors also traveled on incentives (+30%), with a doubling of U.S. East visitors (3,194 from 1,220 in June 2014) and increases from U.S. West (+17%) and Japan (+8.4%). For the first half of 2015, total MCI arrivals rose 7.4 percent to 281,583 visitors.
- For U.S. West, arrivals from the Pacific region gained 8.3 percent compared to June 2014. There were more visitors from California (+10.4%). Arrivals from Oregon grew 3.6 percent from last June. Mountain region arrivals were up 8.9 percent with more visitors from Arizona (+6.6%), Colorado (+10.3%), Nevada (+7.3%) and Utah (+17.1%). For the first half of 2015, arrivals from the Pacific and Mountain regions both showed increases of 9.1 percent.
- All U.S. East regions showed growth in arrivals compared to June 2014, led by New England (+10%), West North Central (+9.3%) and South Atlantic (+9.2%). For the first half of 2015, except for a small drop from West North Central (-1.6%), arrivals from U.S. East regions increased.
- Fewer visitors came to honeymoon (-8.5% to 52,707) or to get married (-10.5% to 10,475) compared to June 2014. The Japanese market which comprised the largest share, showed decreases in both honeymooners (-8.9% to 22,699 visitors) and wedding visitors (-14.1% to 4,108 visitors). There were also declines in both segments from U.S. West (honeymoon -10.6%; get married -22.8%) and U.S. East (honeymoon -11.6%; get married -21.2%). In the first half of 2015, total honeymooners and wedding visitors dropped 2.2 percent and 2.9 percent, respectively.
- Among U.S. East visitors, stays in hotels (+10.8% to 113,013) increased but usage of timeshare properties (-7.4% 19,204) were down. Among Japanese visitors, more stayed in condominiums (+10.3% to 11,623) and timeshare properties (+23.9% to 4,980) but fewer stayed in hotels (-3.9% to 103,203).
- There was significant growth in U.S. East (+41.6% to 9,288) visitors who traveled in group tours in June 2015. In contrast, a greater number of Japanese visitors made their own travel arrangements (+22.2%) but group tours (-6.4%) declined.

Highlights from All Other Markets:

Arrivals by air from developing markets rose 5.7 percent to 99,046 visitors in June 2015 and accounted for 12.9 percent of total air visitors to the Hawaiian Islands. For the first half of 2015, arrivals from All Other Markets were up 8.7 percent to 569,957 visitors.

- **Australia:** Arrivals from Australia increased 11.2 percent to 30,348 visitors in June 2015. For the first half of 2015, arrivals rose 12.8 percent to 157,768 visitors. Australian visitors spent an average of \$253 per person per day, down from \$261 per person per day compared to the first half of 2014. Lodging expenses increased but shopping expenses declined.
- **New Zealand:** There were more visitors from New Zealand (+15.1% to 6,781) compared to June 2014. Through June 2015, arrivals were up 14.9 percent to 27,453 visitors.
- **China:** Arrivals from China grew 13.5 percent to 15,130 visitors. For the first half of 2015, arrivals increased 5.9 percent to 81,879 visitors. Daily spending by these visitors rose to \$399 per person from \$386 in the first half of 2014, and continued to be the highest among the visitor markets. These visitors spent less on lodging and shopping but more on food and beverage, and entertainment and recreation compared to a year ago.

- **Korea:** There were 12,677 visitors from Korea in June 2015, down 10.5 percent from the same month last year. Through June 2015, arrivals dropped 5.6 percent to 83,150 visitors. Korean visitors in the first half of 2015 spent \$287 per person, up from \$272 per person in the first half of 2014. Spending on lodging, shopping, and food and beverage increased but entertainment and recreation expenses were down.
- **Taiwan:** Arrivals from Taiwan declined 5.6 percent to 1,713 visitors. For the first half of 2015, arrivals decreased 31.2 percent to 7,769 visitors.
- **Europe:** There were 10,977 visitors from Europe (United Kingdom, France, Germany, Italy and Switzerland), up 17.1 percent from June 2014. Arrivals during the first half of 2015 (+0.2% to 59,784 visitors) were similar year-to-date 2014.
- **Latin America:** Arrivals from the Latin America market (Mexico, Brazil and Argentina) increased 25.1 percent to 1,937 visitors. However, for the first half of 2015, arrivals from this market declined 2.1 percent to 13,356 visitors.

Island Highlights:

- **O'ahu:** Arrivals to O'ahu rose three percent to 479,264 visitors in June 2015. There were more visitors from U.S. East (+9.3%), Canada (+3.4%) and U.S. West (+1.9%), but fewer from Japan (-2.4%) compared to June 2014. Higher daily visitor spending (+1.3% to \$197 per person) also contributed to a 3.6 percent growth in visitor expenditures to \$652.7 million.
- **Maui:** Arrivals to Maui increased 9.9 percent to 229,002 visitors. There were more visitors who stayed exclusively on Maui (+14%) compared to June 2014, supported by more direct flights to Kahului (+24.1%). Visitor expenditures on this island grew 4.2 percent to \$366.4 million.
- **Hawai'i Island:** Arrivals to Hawai'i Island were up 9.2 percent to 137,323 visitors in June 2015. A greater number of visitors stayed on Hawai'i Island exclusively (+15.9%). More direct seats to Kona (+32.2%) contributed to this increase. However, lower daily spending (-8.3% to \$164 per person) resulted in flat growth in visitor expenditures (+0.2% to \$164.1 million).
- **Kaua'i:** Arrivals grew 3.2 percent to 107,929 visitors in June 2015. Combined with higher daily spending (+13.6% to \$181 per person), visitor expenditures rose 15.5 percent to \$148.4 million.

Air Seats to Hawai'i (Table 9, page 23):

- Air capacity to the Hawaiian Islands increased 9.2 percent to 1,043,885 total seats in June 2015. There were more seats to Honolulu (+3.4% to 698,292), Kahului (+24.1% to 199,809), Kona (+32.2% to 75,610) and Līhu'e (+13% to 65,708), while seat counts to Hilo (-0.4% to 4,466) were similar to June 2014.
- Scheduled seats from U.S. West rose 12 percent from June 2014. Service increased from Denver (+13.7%), Los Angeles (+14.4%), Oakland (+13.9%), Phoenix (+3.9%), Portland (+8.2%), San Francisco (+30%), San Jose (+5.5%) and Seattle (+17.4%), which offset discontinued service from Eugene, Fresno, Phoenix Mesa and fewer seats from Bellingham (-59%) and Las Vegas (-2.9%).
- Scheduled seats from U.S. East grew 21.6 percent, with more seats out of Atlanta (+28.3%), Chicago (+47.1%), Dallas (+37.8%) and Houston (+4.1%).
- Scheduled seats from Japan dropped 4.5 percent in June 2015. The number of seats out of Fukuoka declined 66.6 percent, as one airline discontinued this route in July 2014. There were also fewer seats out of Nagoya (-12.4%), which were partially offset by more seats from Osaka (+8.5%) and Narita (+2.6%).

- Scheduled seats out of Canada increased 26.5 percent, with more seats from Vancouver to Honolulu (+33.9%) and Kahului (+22.6%) compared to June 2014.
- Scheduled seats from Oceania grew 20.2 percent. Seats out of Brisbane nearly doubled and there were significantly more seats from Melbourne (+44.4%) and Sydney (+7%). Seats out of Auckland increased 10 percent from June 2014.
- Scheduled seats from Other Asia decreased 14.5 percent. For the China market, there were fewer seats out of Shanghai (-22.7%) and Beijing (-4.3%). For Taiwan, seats out of Taipei dropped 11.1 percent from last June. For the Korea market, the number of seats from Seoul was down 15.7 percent.
- Through June 2015, total air capacity rose 7.4 percent to 5,937,099 seats. Growth in seats to Honolulu (+3.3% to 3,997,429), Kahului (+19.4% to 1,165,532), Kona (+21.1% to 415,844) and Līhu'e (+6.1% to 338,516) offset fewer seats to Hilo (-11.9% to 19,678).

Cruise Ship Visitors (Table 8, page 22):

- June through August is typically the slow season for out-of-state cruise ships to Hawai'i. One cruise ship came in June 2015 and brought 497 visitors while two ships came in June 2014 with 1,397 visitors. In the first half of 2015, there were 59,612 visitors who entered the islands aboard 34 out-of-state cruise ships. This was a decrease of 22.8 percent compared to the 77,168 visitors who came on 43 cruise ships in the first half of 2014.
- In total, the number of cruise visitors (arrivals by cruise ships and by air to board cruise ships in Hawai'i) dropped 7.1 percent to 10,538 visitors in June 2015. Through the first half of 2015 there were 121,621 total cruise visitors, which was a 10.8 percent decline from the same period last year.
