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**HAWAII VISITOR ARRIVALS SET NEW RECORD FOR NOVEMBER;
EXTENDS STREAK OF NINE CONSECUTIVE MONTHLY RECORDS
TOTAL VISITOR EXPENDITURES INCREASED 2.5 PERCENT**

HONOLULU – Total visitor arrivals to the Hawaiian Islands in November 2015 set a new record for the month with 661,352 visitors, a 3.7 percent growth year-over-year compared to November 2014, according to preliminary statistics released today by the Hawaii Tourism Authority (HTA). November marked the ninth straight month total visitor arrivals have surpassed the previous monthly records.

Visitor arrivals on airlines increased in November 2015 (+4.5% to 657,603), with the balance arriving on cruise ships (-56.4% to 3,749 visitors).

Year-over-year growth in arrivals on airlines from U.S. West (+5.1% to 285,638) and U.S. East (+9.5% to 119,167) more than offset a decrease from Canada (-4.8% to 43,197). Visitor arrivals from Japan (+0.3% to 122,840) were comparable to November 2014, while arrivals from all other international markets increased for the month (+7.3% to 86,761).

Hawaii's four larger islands realized growth in visitor arrivals in November compared to the year prior: O'ahu (+4.1% to 407,570), Maui (+2.8% to 193,355), Kaua'i (+0.8% to 83,021), and Hawaii Island (+0.5% to 107,558).

More visitors stayed exclusively on one island this November – Maui (+7.5%), O'ahu (+6.3%), Kaua'i (+5.7%), and Hawaii Island (+4.7%) – compared to November 2014, while fewer visitors (-4%) stayed on multiple islands.

Total visitor expenditures grew in November 2015 (+2.5% to \$1.1 billion) compared to the year prior, driven by a 3 percent increase in total visitor days¹, which compensated for slightly lower per person per day spending (-0.5% to \$196 per person).

Among Hawaii's top four visitor markets, visitor expenditures increased from U.S. West (+6.6% to \$430.7 million) and U.S. East (+7.3% to \$254.8 million), but declined from Japan (-7.2% to \$174.9 million) and Canada (-12.3% to \$80.6 million).

Hawaii's four larger islands saw year-over-year increases in visitor expenditures in November: Kaua'i (+9.7% to \$115.9 million), Maui (+5.2% to \$320.4 million), Hawaii Island (+2.6% to \$143.4 million), and O'ahu (+0.7% to \$557 million).

There were 927,289 total air seats to the Hawaiian Islands in November 2015, up 4.4 percent from a year ago. Growth in scheduled seats from Canada (+16.9%), Oceania (+8.2%), U.S. West (+5.7%), U.S. East (+4.8%) and Other Asia (+1.2%) offset a 1.8 percent decline in seats from Japan.

Year-to-Date 2015

In the first 11 months of 2015, total visitor arrivals (+4.2% to 7,855,111) and visitor expenditures (+2.2% to \$13.6 billion) maintained its positive pace over the same period in 2014. Growth in arrivals from U.S. West (+7%) and U.S. East (+2.8%) offset slightly fewer arrivals from Japan (-0.8%). Gains in U.S. West visitor expenditures (+6.4% to \$4.8 billion), counter-balanced a slight drop in U.S. East spending (-0.8% to \$3.3 billion) and a decline from Japan (-9.7% to \$2 billion). Expenditures of \$943.4 million by visitors from Canada in the first 11 months of 2015 were similar to the same period last year.

Year-to-date, Maui (+5.1%), Kaua'i (+4.5%), Hawai'i Island (+3.9%) and O'ahu (+2.6%) experienced growth in visitor arrivals compared to the first 11 months of 2014. Visitor expenditures increased for Maui (+5.8% to \$3.8 billion), Kaua'i (+14.6% to \$1.5 billion) and Hawai'i Island (+1% to \$1.7 billion), but dropped for O'ahu (-1.4% to \$6.5 billion).

Other Highlights:

- **U.S. West:** Visitor arrivals from the Pacific region increased 5.9 percent in November versus last year, with growth from Alaska (+13.5%), Washington (+6.5%), California (+5.9%) and Oregon (+1.6%). Arrivals from the Mountain region rose 4 percent, led by Utah (+11.3%), which has shown double-digit gains in every month this year. Through the first 11 months of 2015, arrivals from the Pacific region were up 7.1 percent, while the Mountain region grew by 8.3 percent.
- **U.S. East:** Every region showed growth in visitor arrivals in November compared to the year prior. Arrivals from the two largest regions, South Atlantic and East North Central, rose 12.2 percent and 11 percent, respectively. There were increased arrivals from all U.S. East regions through the first 11 months of 2015. In November 2015, more U.S. East visitors stayed exclusively in hotels (+11.1% to 61,890), while usage of timeshares declined from a year ago (-8.8% to 11,593). Stays in other accommodations, such as a rental house, increased year-over-year (+38% to 2,736).
- **Japan:** More visitors stayed in condominiums (+18.2%) and timeshares (+5.1%), but hotel usage was down slightly (-1.6%) in November 2015. Since June 2015, there has been greater usage of condominiums and timeshares by Japanese visitors and decreasing hotel stays compared to last year. November 2015 marked the seventh straight month of double-digit growth in independent travelers from Japan. In addition, November saw a 27.2 percent drop in honeymoon visitors and was the third straight month of double-digit declines despite October and November being traditional peak honeymoon months in Hawai'i for couples from Japan.
- **Canada:** Growth in visitor arrivals on direct international flights from Canada (+16.9%) offset the decrease in visitors from Canada on U.S. domestic flights (-33.4%) in November 2015. Timeshare usage by visitors from Canada increased (+6.9%) while stays in hotels (-6.5%) and condominiums (-11.2%) were lower compared to November 2014.
- **MCI:** A total of 39,329 visitors came for meetings, conventions and incentives (MCI) in November 2015, down 5.5 percent from last November. There were fewer convention visitors (-10.7% to 19,981) compared to November 2014 (when the Jehovah's Witnesses' convention of 18,000+ delegates took place at the Hawai'i Convention Center). The number of visitors who traveled on incentives increased 4 percent, boosted by a 30.2 percent growth from the Japanese market. For the first 11 months of 2015, total MCI visitors increased (+5.1% to 457,708 visitors).

Highlights from All Other Markets:

Estimated visitor arrivals on airlines from developing international markets rose 7.3 percent to 86,761 visitors in November 2015, and visitor days increased 11.6 percent to 821,600 days. Year-to-date, arrivals grew 7.2 percent to 1,098,937 visitors, and visitor days were up 9.8 percent.

- **Australia:** Visitor arrivals increased for both November (+4.2% to 24,517) and through the first 11 months (+9.8% to 308,175) compared to last year.
- **New Zealand:** Visitor arrivals dropped in November year-over-year (-1.4% to 4,303) but remained ahead of last year's pace for the first 11 months (+3.4% to 58,461).
- **China:** Visitor arrivals grew year-over-year for both November (+8.1% to 10,701) and through the first 11 months (+6.3% to 157,672).
- **Korea:** Visitor arrivals increased in November (+3.2% to 14,279), but continued to trail last year's pace through the first 11 months (-6.5% to 150,487).
- **Taiwan:** Visitor arrivals dropped in November (-4% to 1,160) and remained behind last year's totals for the first 11 months (-19.3% to 15,390).
- **Europe:** Visitor arrivals from the United Kingdom, France, Germany, Italy and Switzerland declined in November 2015 (-14.2% to 8,336) and were slightly behind the year-to-date pace compared to 2014 (-1.9% to 130,127).
- **Latin America:** Visitor arrivals from Mexico, Brazil and Argentina decreased in November 2015 (-18.6% to 1,387) visitors and were down year-over-year compared to the first 11 months of 2014 (-7.7% to 24,216).

Island Highlights:

- **O'ahu:** Visitor arrivals grew in November 2015 (+4.1% to 407,570), with visitor days also increasing by 5.5 percent. Visitor expenditures increased slightly (+0.7% to \$557 million), despite lower daily spending (-4.5% to \$206 per person). More visitors came from U.S. East (+13.7%) and U.S. West (+3.5%), with fewer visitors from Canada (-1.2%) compared to November 2014.
- **Maui:** Visitor arrivals (+2.8% to 193,355) and visitor days (+3.8%) both increased in November 2015. Visitor expenditures grew (+5.2% to \$320.4 million), bolstered by higher daily spending (+1.3% to \$198 per person). Growth in arrivals from U.S. West (+3.6%) and U.S. East (+3.8%) offset declines from Japan (-7.9%) and Canada (-3.7%).
- **Hawai'i Island:** Visitor arrivals (+0.5% to 107,558 visitors) and visitor days (+0.2%) increased slightly in November 2015 versus the year prior. Visitor expenditures increased (+2.6% to \$143.4 million) due to higher daily spending (+2.4% to \$176 per person). Arrivals from U.S. West increased (+3.1%) to maintain a streak of year-over-year increases in every month of 2015. More direct flights from U.S. West cities to Kona have supported this growth and resulted in more U.S. West visitors staying exclusively on Hawai'i Island (+5.2%). Significantly more visitors from Japan stayed exclusively on Hawai'i Island in November 2015 (+65.2% to 2,611) compared to a year ago. Visitors from Canada decreased by 14.9 percent.
- **Kaua'i:** Visitor arrivals rose slightly (+0.8% to 83,021), and visitor days were up 1.9 percent in November 2015. Visitor expenditures showed a notable increase (+9.7% to \$115.9 million), with increased daily spending (+7.7% to \$183 per person) being a contributing factor. Fewer visitors came from Canada (-15.1% to 5,774) compared to November 2014, which corresponded with a drop in air seats from Vancouver to Līhu'e (-3.4%). The Japan market, which had produced double-digit growth the previous two months, declined 9.7 percent compared to last November.

Air Seats to Hawai'i (Table 9, page 23):

- In November 2015, total seat capacity to the Hawaiian Islands increased 4.4 percent to 927,289 seats. Growth in seats to Kahului (+7.6%), Kona (+18.7%) and Hilo (+2.1%) offset fewer seats to Līhu'e (-5.1%). There were more scheduled seats (+4.5% to 922,321) but fewer chartered seats (-2% to 4,968) compared to November 2014.
- Scheduled seats from U.S. West grew 5.7 percent in November 2015 year-over-year. Increased service from Anchorage (+37.8%), Oakland (+9%), Portland (+4.3%), San Diego (+9.4%), San Francisco (+31.3%) and Seattle (+16.5%) compensated for decreased service from Los Angeles (-4.7%) and Denver (-16.5%).
- Scheduled seats from U.S. East rose 4.8 percent in November 2015. New seasonal service out of Minneapolis offset fewer seats from Chicago (-2.9%).
- More seats from Vancouver (+16.5%) and Calgary (+28.6%) in November 2015 contributed to a 16.9 percent growth in scheduled seats out of Canada.
- Scheduled seats from Oceania grew 8.2 percent in November 2015. Seats from Brisbane nearly doubled, in addition to increased service from Melbourne (+10.6%). In contrast, seats out of Auckland dropped 2.9 percent compared to November 2014.
- Scheduled seats from Other Asia markets rose 1.2 percent in November 2015. Total seats from China increased 4.9 percent as a result of more seats out of Shanghai (+13.3%). Seats out of Taipei decreased 10.1 percent. The number of seats from Seoul (+0.8%) rose slightly from last November.
- Year-to-date, total air capacity into Hawai'i grew 6 percent to 10,845,445 seats in the first 11 months of 2015. Growth in seats to Honolulu (+2.9%), Kahului (+15.5%), Kona (+18.5%) and Līhu'e (+3.1%) offset fewer seats to Hilo (-4.2%).

Cruise Ship Visitors (Table 8, page 22):

- Two out-of-state cruise ships came in November 2015 and brought 3,749 visitors to the islands, compared to the six ships that came in November 2014 with 8,600 visitors. Changes in itineraries in the fall cruise season contributed to this decline as several of the ships that came in November 2014 shifted their Hawai'i visits to October 2015. In addition, electrical issues forced another ship to cancel its Hawai'i voyage. Through the first 11 months of 2015, 108,611 visitors entered Hawai'i on 59 out-of-state cruise ships. This was down 2.7 percent compared to the 111,680 visitors who came on 64 cruise ships through year-to-date 2014.
- In total, the number of cruise visitors (arrivals by cruise ships and by air to board cruise ships in Hawai'i) decreased 34.7 percent to 12,679 in November 2015. Through the first 11 months of 2015, there were 224,421 total cruise visitors which was an increase of 1.4 percent from the same period last year.
