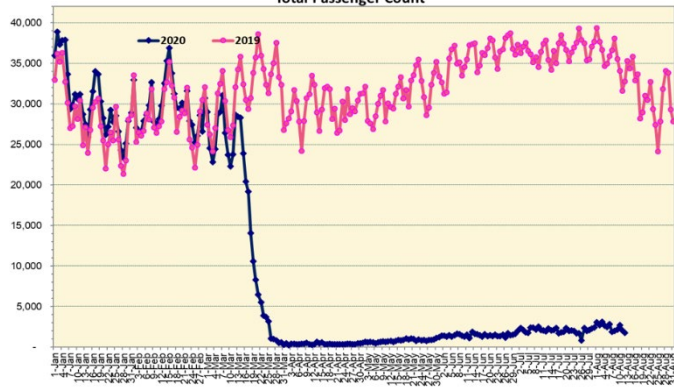

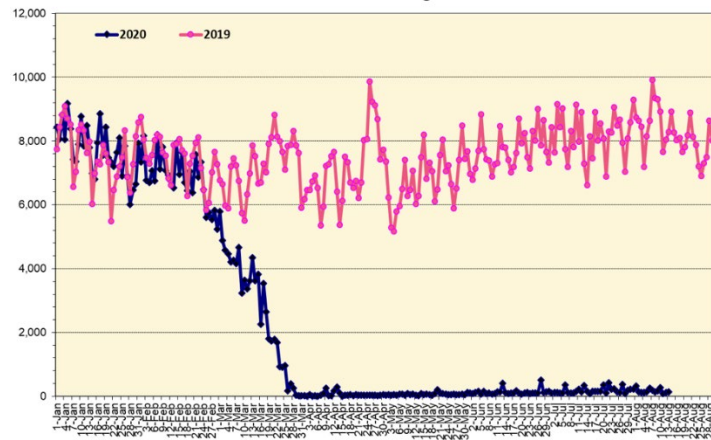

Total Passenger Count



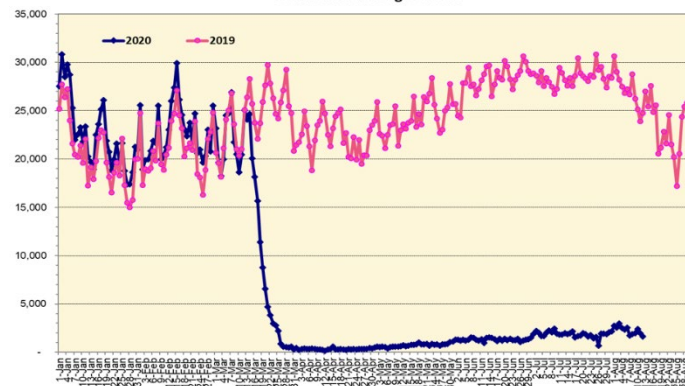

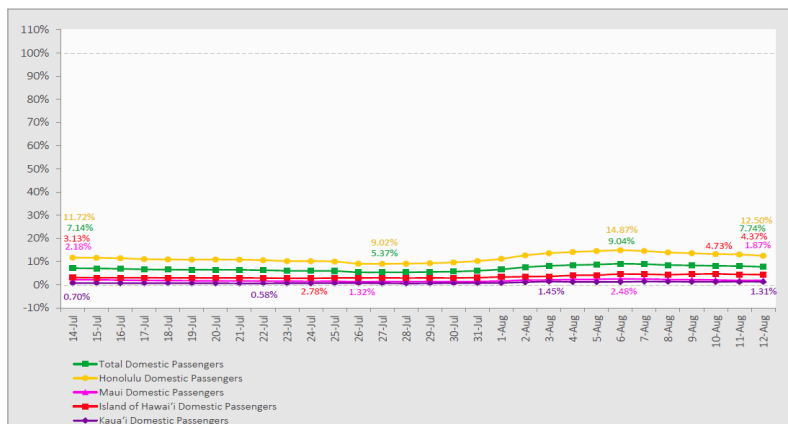

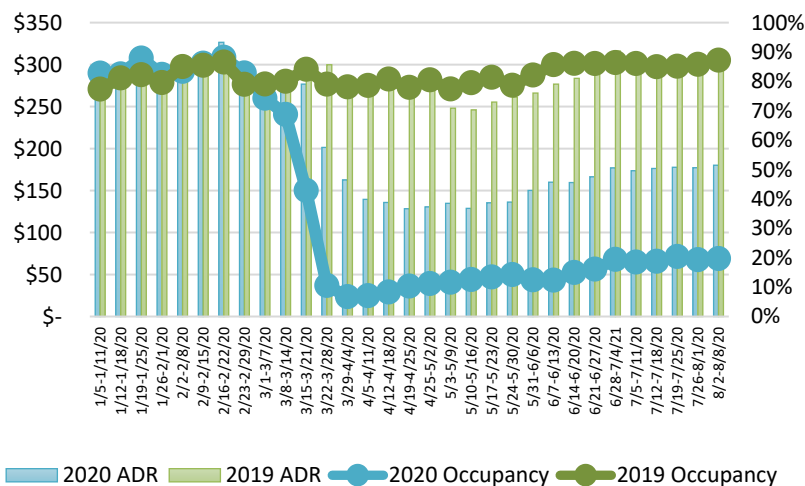

State of Hawai'i Hotel Performance by Week - 2020 vs 2019



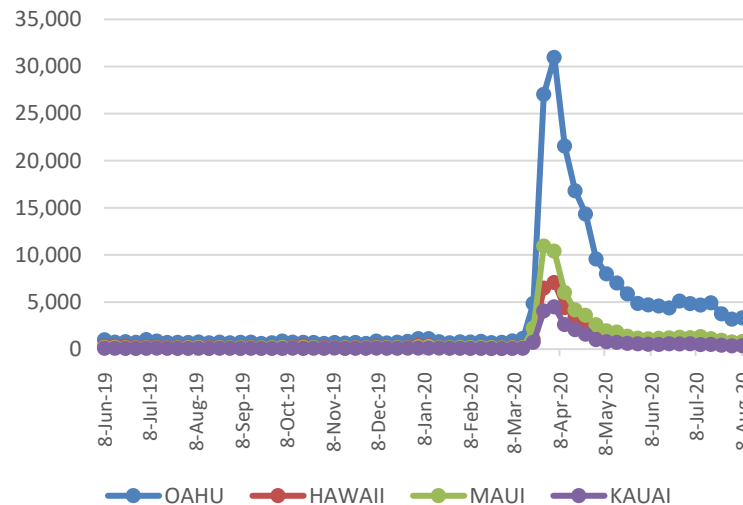

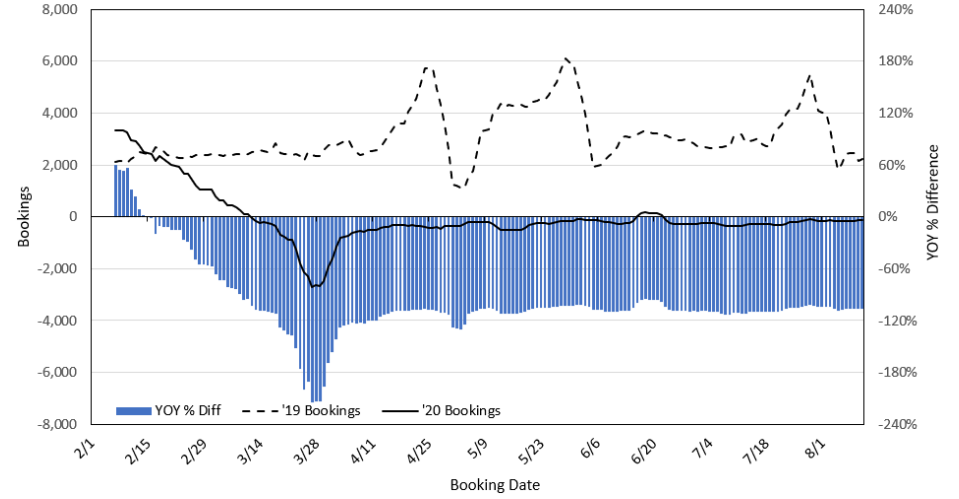

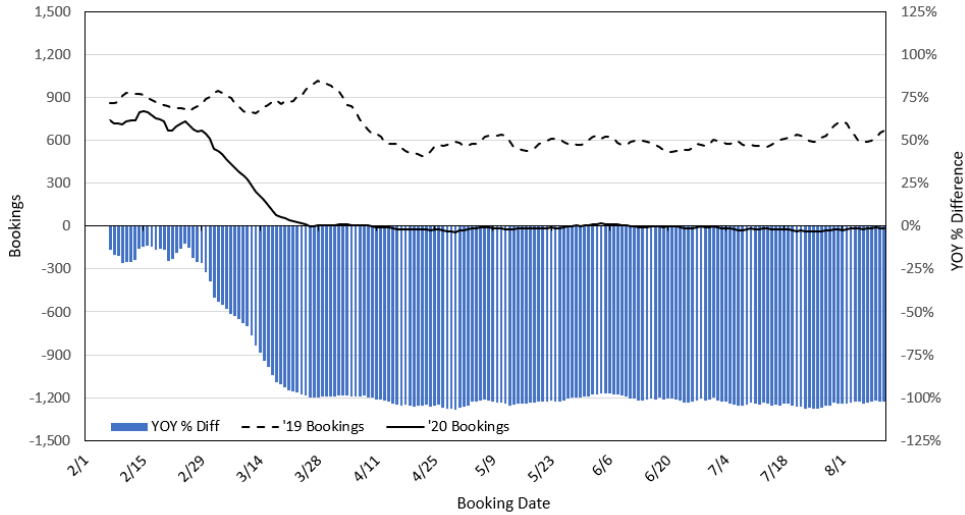
Travel Agency Bookings to Hawaii for Future Arrivals*

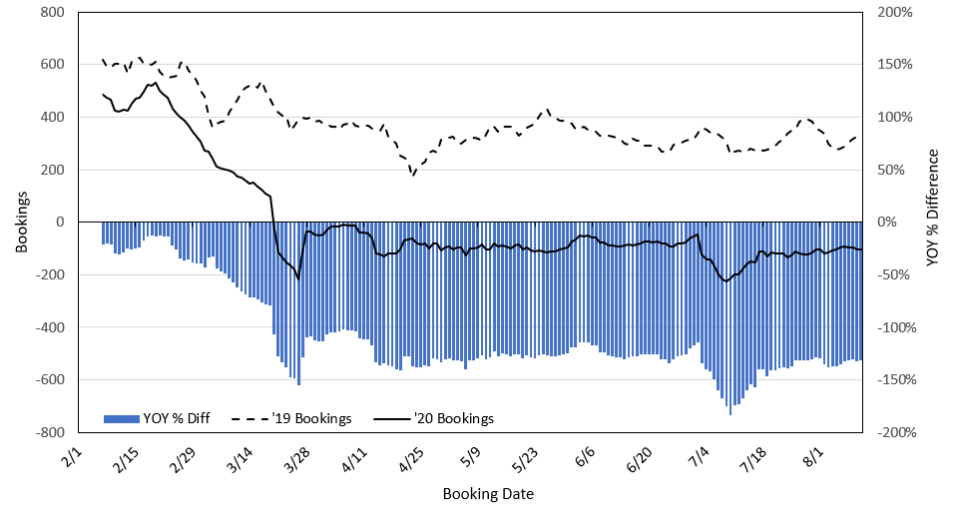

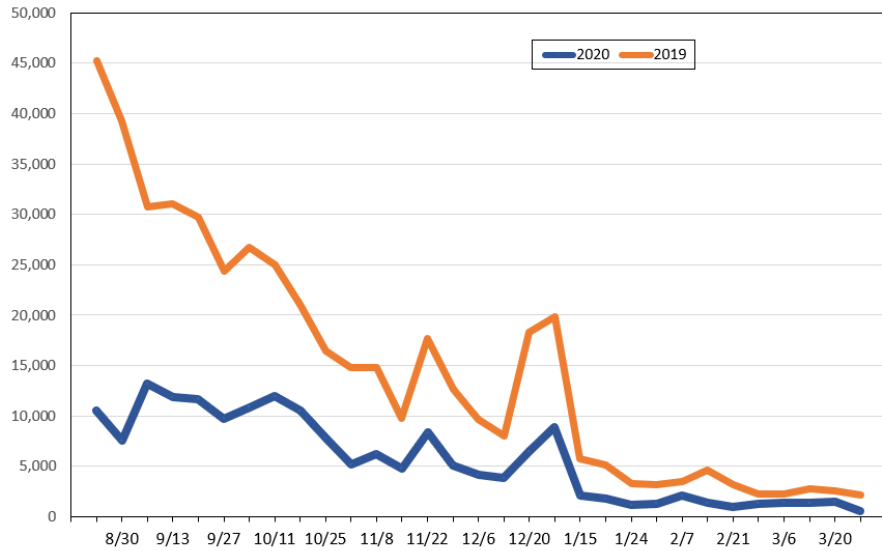

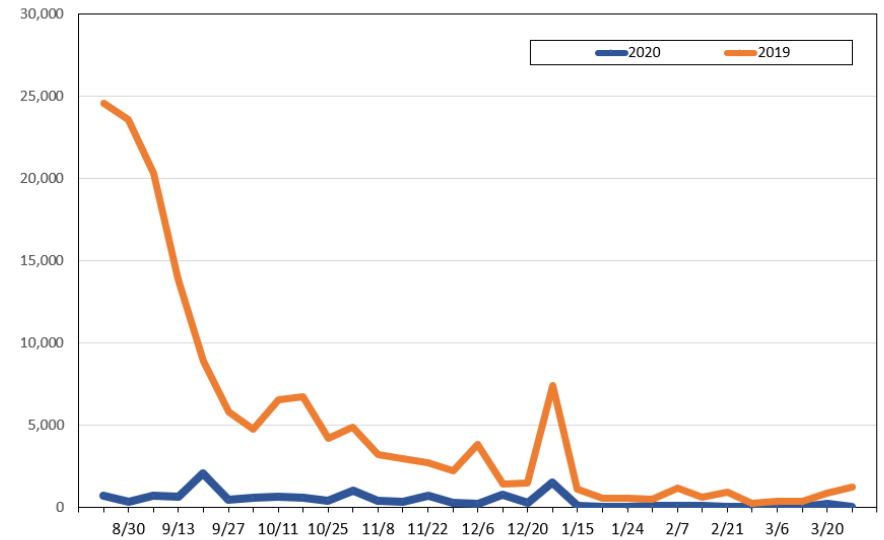

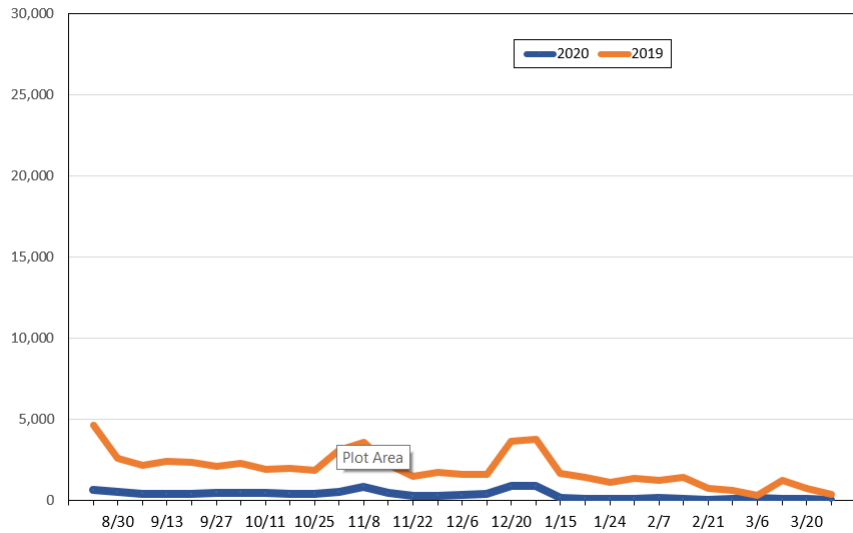

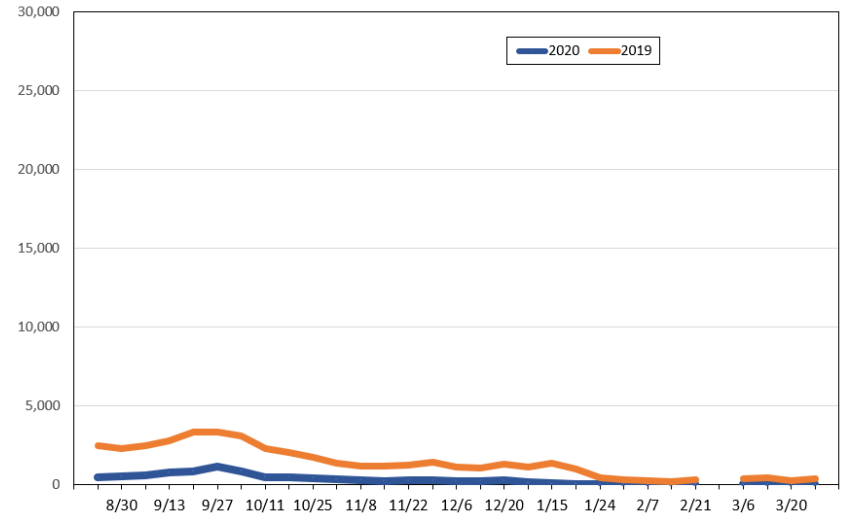
